MGMT100 Human Relations in Organization

This is one of the first courses that I took in pursuit of my dual degrees over two years ago, and from what I remember of it, the class served as a general introduction to workplace related subject matter and interactions between people.

The curriculum covered a broad base of subjects including attitude, leadership, mentoring, personality, conflict management, cultural differences, self-esteem, motivation, and ethics in the workplace. This class served as a foundation for other management classes that covered some of these same subjects in greater depth or from a differing viewpoint.
