

Critique 2

There are multiple songs that have a personal meaning to me. If I was to choose the top 12 of these songs then I would pick Rivers And Roads, New Low, The Cave, Virgin, Midnight City, Somebody That I Used To Know, We Used To Wait, Kettering, Ho Hey, Howlin' For You, and Sometime Around Midnight.
