## **DESCRIPTION OF THE COURSE:**

Students working toward the CIS degree, who are in the second year of their course work, receive on-the-job training in information systems. One credit can be earned for each 30 hours worked. (Half credits are available for 15 hours.)

## **COURSE WORK:**

## COURSE EVALUATION:

Successful completion of student responsibilities in this class requires access to Canvas via an Internet browser. You are expected to login to the Canvas classroom 1 time during the two weeks of class to familiarize yourself with the materials available, and after that I will send you email and/or email announcements if I need to contact you.

### Grade:

Provided you submit your signed paperwork according to the timelines above, you will receive a “S” – satisfactory grade - if your supervisor has evaluated you in at least 4 categories as “met expectations” (or above) on the Evaluation Form. You will receive a “U” – unsatisfactory grade - if your supervisor rates you “needs improvement” in 3 or more categories on the Evaluation Form.

### Credits:

You will receive the appropriate number of credits that your supervisor has signed off on – 1 credit = 30 hours, with half credits (15) hour increments available, provided you have received a “S” grade for the course.

## POLICY ON V AND I GRADES:

“V” grades mean an instructor-initiated withdrawal. This may be the final grade if an instructor initiates a class withdrawal before the end of the quarter, often in consultation with the student, but also if a student enrolls in a class, but never attends or stops attending class. A faculty member is under no obligation to grant an instructor-initiated withdrawal. I award V grades if a student fails to continue the class, and only approximately ¼ or less of the course work has been completed.

“I” grade means Incomplete and they are given at the discretion of the instructor and only when the student has done satisfactory work, but could not complete part of the course work or take the final examination. To receive an incomplete, the student and instructor must complete and sign the Incomplete Contract that sets a deadline – not to exceed one year – and quality standards for the work to be completed. If the contract is not satisfactorily completed by the deadline, the ‘I’ grade remains on the student transcript.

**I WILL NOT AWARD AN ‘I’ GRADE BECAUSE YOU DO NOT SUBMIT YOUR MATERIALS BY THE DEADLINE ABOVE OR IF YOU REGISTERED FOR THE WRONG NUMBER OF CREDITS. I WILL ONLY AWARD AN ‘I’ GRADE IF YOU CONTACT ME IN ADVANCE OF FINALS AND, DUE TO CIRCUMSTANCES OUTSIDE YOUR CONTROL, YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO COMPLETE REQUIRED MATERIALS. ADDITIONALLY, I WILL NOT AWARD AN ‘I’ GRADE UNLESS WE COMPLETE AND SIGN THE INCOMPLETE GRADE CONTRACT REQUIRED BY THE COLLEGE. THIS MUST BE DONE PRIOR TO FINALS WEEK.**
